April 11 RACCOON CREEK WILDFLOWER RESERVE

April 18 - NORTH PARK

Meet at Pie Traynor Ballfield Parking Lot near the swimming pool. There should be Trailing Arbutus in abundance. Leader, Roger Kennedy.

April 25 - CONNOQUENESSING CREEK AT BEAVER RIVER

This appears to be an interesting area. It was recommended by Mr. Buker and will be new territory for most of us. Take Turnpike West to Exit #2, route 18 to Koppel, route 351 across Beaver River and park on left at end of bridge; or from Zelienople take route 288 to Ellwood City and route 351 to bridge crossing Beaver River. May 2 - JEFFERSON LAKE STATE PARK, OHIO

This is a small park rich in wildflowers, and it should be interesting to explore. Take route 22 to Steubenville and from there Ohio state route 43 approximately 15 miles. Watch for State Park sign by road on right. Meet at first parking area. Leader, Esther Allen.

May 9 - GUFFEY HOLLOW

Meet at Irwin Turnpike Interchange Park-and-Ride lot. We shall be seeing Blue-Eyed-Mary and a host of other spring wildflowers. Leader, Peggy Wisner.
